2021 VBS Volunteer Roles / Job Descriptions

Preschool CLASSROOM: Lead Teacher

Lead activities relating to the Daily Bible Lesson and lead the class through their rotations for the day for Pre-K and Kindergarten. Younger classes have fewer rotations and more classroom time. The Daily Bible Lesson is taught in a VBS rotation stop, not by the classroom teachers. This role is with a 2-3 person team sharing the responsibilities with the class.

Preschool CLASSROOM: Assistant Teacher

Assist with activities related to the Daily Bible Lesson and assist leading the class through their daily rotations. The Daily Bible Lesson is taught in a VBS rotation stop, not by the classroom teachers. This role is with a 2-3 person team sharing the responsibilities with the class.

Elementary CLASSROOM: Lead Teacher

Plan and teach the Daily Bible Lesson to two class rotations per day. This is a rotation stop, not a role where you accompany the class throughout the day. This role has a team of 2-3 people per classroom sharing the responsibilities of the planning and teaching.

Elementary CLASSROOM: Assistant Teacher

Accompany a class throughout their day at VBS. This is NOT a planning role or a teaching role. The only teaching is to support and reinforce the Daily Bible Lesson through natural conversations and interactions with the children in your class. This role has a team of 2-4 people sharing and helping lead the class throughout their day at VBS.

CLASSROOM: Youth Leader (K-5th Grade Only)

Accompany a class throughout their day at VBS. This is NOT a planning role or a teaching role. The only teaching is to support and reinforce the Daily Bible Lesson through natural conversations and interactions with the children in your class. This role has a team of 2-4 people sharing and helping lead the class throughout their day at VBS. *Youth may also request to help in a Bible Study rotation where more teaching is needed.

Bible Story Team:

Assist in Elementary or Preschool presenting the Daily Bible Lesson through storying and other activities.

SPECIAL NEEDS: Buddy

Pair up with a child with special needs to assist them during VBS.

Decision Counseling:

Decision counselors meet with children who have responded to the Gospel on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday of VBS.

Decoration & Set-Up:

Bring your creative flair and/or willingness to jump in with decoration and set up needs leading up to VBS.

Family Night Volunteer Team:

A great role for those who may not be available during the day as we welcome families to celebrate VBS. Greeters, game attendants, and friendly faces are needed!

Greeting Team:

Welcome children and their parents with a smile each morning along with checking out children at the end of the day as they depart.

Missions Team:

Lead or assist with activities in the preschool missions rotations.

Parking Team:

The FIRST FACES our children will see each day at VBS! Welcome the families and direct traffic during drop off and pick up.

Recreation:

Lead or assist with activities in the elementary or preschool recreation rotation.

Registration Team:

Greet families and assist with enrolling children at VBS each day.

Snack Team:

Organize and portion snacks while delivering snack to each class in preschool and elementary during VBS.

Worship Band:

If you are able to help with the Worship Band during VBS week, please sign up!
